The role of the Chair

Principle responsibilities

- 1. To provide leadership to SBKA members and the branch committee.
- 2. To ensure the branch committee provides effective governance to SBKA.
- 3. To represent SBKA at Cheshire committee meetings and some other occasional county events.
- 4. To Chair the four annual SBKA committee meetings.
- 5. To represent SBKA at some external functions, meetings and events.
- 6. Work closely with the Branch secretary to review and maintain branch systems and processes.
- 7. To ensure the Branch finances are maintained robustly as directed by Cheshire Beekeepers.

Time commitment

There are four SBKA committee meetings annually and four CBKA, with occasional meetings when required.

The Chair should attend some of the 12 monthly member meetings, and it is desirable to be present at some of the beginner's classes and occasional local events.
